You will receive information about the application procedure after you have been nominated by your home college.

# GOOD TO KNOW

#### Small-Scale and Interactive Classes

The LAS program is a small-scale program, characterized by a high level of student activity and interaction. Students are expected to actively contribute to tutorials on a regular basis by debating and arguing their point of view, by presenting a research assignment or a paper they have written. The small class size and the interactive character of the program allow for a strong emphasis on the training of academic skills.

#### Interdisciplinary Approach

Students are taught to approach complex issues from different perspectives and a variety of academic disciplines. To achieve this, several courses are team-taught, with two lecturers from different fields jointly teaching the course, demonstrating how you can approach a question or issue from different angles right in front of the classroom.

#### Larger Network

Students in the program are able to benefit from being part of a tight community of LAS students, while also mingling with all of Tilburg University's programs and nationalities as we are located on its vibrant, multicultural, and beautiful, green campus.
