DEADLINE OF APPLICATION for spring 2023: OCTOBER 23, 2022
Interested University College students can indicate their choice to follow courses at UCM, by filling out the online application document before October 23, 2022. You will receive information about the next steps after you have been nominated by your home college.

Tuition fees or other (administrative) fees do not apply. Possible extra costs incurred through this exchange are the student's responsibility. There are no scholarships attached to this exchange.

GOOD TO KNOW

PROBLEM BASED LEARNING

All courses at University College Maastricht are taught following the Problem Based Learning (PBL). PBL is a student driven education method with the tutor's responsibility that the learning goals are met. Courses are constructed as following:

- Small tutorial groups (10-12 students)
- Real-life or academic problems (cases) as the starting point of learning process
- Discussions and analysis under guidance of a tutor
- Questions from analysis will be used as a guide for self-study (from handbooks and articles)
- Students report back in the next tutorial meeting and discuss findings with other students and tutor

Assessment is consisting of assignments (presentations, essays) and exams.

INTRODUCTION PROGRAMME

The UCM Introduction Programme (Fall: Monday 29 - Wednesday 31 August. Spring: Monday 30 January - Wednesday 1 February) provides useful information about settling into Maastricht, UCM's education systems, and our Problem-Based Learning methodology.
